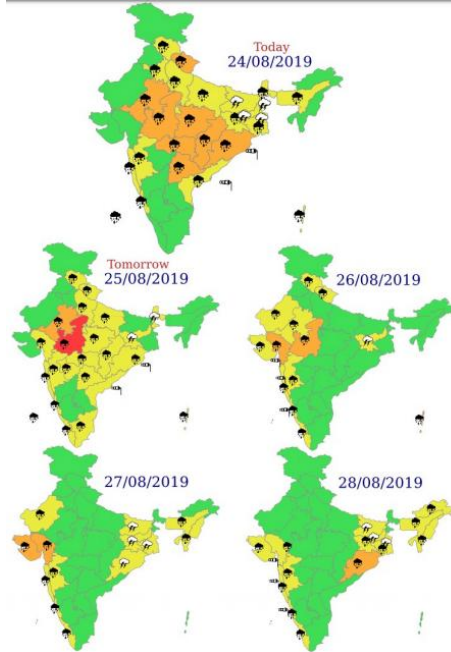

### 2.1.1 Ganga Basin

River Ganga is flowing in Above Normal to Severe Flood Situation at Kachhla Bridge in Badaun District, Ghazipur in Ghazipur District, Ballia in Ballia District of Uttar Pradesh, Buxar in Buxar District, Patna Dighaghat, Patna Gandhighat & Hathidah in Patna district of Bihar, Bhagalpur & Kahalgaon in Bhagalpur District of Bihar, Sahebganj in Sahebganj District of Jharkhand and at Farakka Barrage in Murshidabad District in West Bengal. River Ghaghra is flowing in Severe to Above Normal flood situation in Barabanki, Faizabad and Ballia Districts of Uttar Pradesh and in Siwan District of Bihar.

### 2.1.3 Subarnarekha, Brahmani & Baitarni, Mahanadi, East Flowing Rivers between Mahanadi & Godavari in Odisha

Rivers Baitarni at Akhuapada in Bhadrak District and Mathani at Mathani Road Bridge in Balasore District are flowing in Above Normal to Severe Flood Situation. Due to forecast of heavy to very heavy rain in Odisha for next 24 hours, rivers Subarnarekha, Baitarni, Brahmani and Mahanadi are likely to rise.

### 2.1.4 Mahanadi, Godavari, Narmada, Tapi, Betwa, Ken, Sone Basins in Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha Portion of Maharashtra and Chhattisgarh

Due to forecast of heavy to very heavy rain in Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha and Chhattisgarh, there is high probability of rise in water levels in the basins of Mahanadi, Wainganga, Wardha, Indravathi, Sabari, Rihand, Sone, Narmada, Tapi, Ken & Betwa Basins during next 2-3 days. Since most of the dams are very near FRL in these basins, maximum cautions has to be exercised in releasing water to downstream regions.

<b>Chhattisgarh:</b>	Districts in the basins of Indravathi, Sabari, Mahanadi, Rihand
<b>Madhya Pradesh:</b>	Districts in the basins of Wainganga, Wardha, Narmada, Tapi, Ken, Betwa, Sone
<b>Maharashtra:</b>	Districts in the basins of Wainganga, Wardha, Indravathi, Penganga
